

Minutes of Pula Amateur Radio Club Meeting held
June 12, 1967 at Radio, Inc.

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 PM CDST by president Ray Elidden W5N00. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. Phil Garver W5ZB1 Treasurer reported a balance of \$215.58 in the club treasury. Among visitors introduced were KHL6EB John Phillips and WAB6TH Gloria Phillips who are moving here from Hawaii. A question was asked regarding the \$25 donation to the Electron Banders Club for repairs to a portable generator. President Ray asked for a review of the purpose of the donation and a short discussion followed. The interference committee had nothing to report. A member of the publicity committee commented on recent newspaper articles which have been beneficial to the Amateur Radio cause. Mark De Stoff W5FLE reported on the television publicity to be given Pula amateurs in connection with the Communication to be provided by amateurs during the Powder Puff Derby July 8, 9, and 10. Mark also reminded us that volunteer operators were still needed to man the station which will be set up at Riverside Airport. Ken Weinberger W5YKE Secretary announced that it will be necessary for him to resign immediately due to a requirement that he attend some school. There was a question about the kind of school he would be attending - a girls school perhaps - however, his resignation was accepted by President Ray and nominations were opened for a new secretary. Norm Smith W5EYK and Larry Barr W5MQH were nominated and Larry Barr W5MQH was elected by secret ballot. A question arose about a vacancy in the Pula Council of Amateur Radio Clubs to be filled by a member of TARC. It was determined that a vacancy did exist and President Ray opened nominations to fill this vacancy. Norm Smith W5EYK was nominated and elected by acclamation to this position. Bert Gunn W5FU reported on the illness of Bob Morrow W5FWZ. Bob is in very serious condition in room 313 St. Francis Hospital in Pula. Bert suggested that

QSL cards be sent to Bob. Bert also announced this on QCW net.

The program was presented by John Phillips KH6GEB who gave a very interesting and informative account of Amateur Radio Operations in Hawaii.
