



ARES Tulsa County 24 Hour Deployment Checklist

Communications Go bog

- Dual band handheld radio and speaker/mic (with spare battery & charger)
- Dual band Mobile/Base unit
- Magnetic mount antenna and/or roll up type antenna with paracord support
- Coax: RG-58/U
- Connectors and adapters: PL-259/SO-239 TO BNC, PL-259/SO-239 to SMA (male and female), N, barrel connectors, etc.
- Extended gain antenna for HT
- Electrical tape and duct tape
- Small tools; larger tool case in car
- Spare AA and AAA batteries
- Club Shirt, ID (copy of Amateur license), Hi Visibility Vest, OKMRC ID
- Water bottle (2 quarts)
- Snacks: Granola bars, Power Bars, trail mix
- Sun Screen, Chapstick, Bug Spray
- First-aid kit (Motrin, Imodium, Dramamine, Tylenol, Benadryl, earplugs, whistle)
- Prescription medications
- Toilet paper in a Ziploc bag (compress the air out), Kleenex
- Towel (small)
- Pocket knife (multifunction)
- Flashlights
- Digital Camera or camera on you phone
- Pens, pencils, markers, note pad
- Repeater directory (optional)
- Maps (AAA area or Thomas Guides)
- Wicked Weather gear - Ski hat and gloves, leather gloves with liners, rain poncho, collapsible umbrella, ball cap, dry socks
- Space blanket
- Waterproof matches, butane lighters
- Paracord (two 50-foot lengths)
- Roll of black electrical tape
- Garbage bags (two 55 gallon, four large ziplock)
- AM/FM radio and batteries

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- Binoculars
- Four Cyalume light sticks (12-hour, green)
- Dust mask and wind goggles
- Batteries for personal devices

Optional

- State OKFOG, FEMA NIFOG
- IPAD or tablet PC with chargers
- ICS / NTS forms kit (including a copy of your FCC license)
- Charged power bank with appropriate cables
- Dual band antenna with magnetic mount for mobile use
- Roll up J-pole antenna, coax, hoist line
